
The real Duke of Milan

4 Prospero is the real Duke of Milan, but he does not live in Milan: he lives on a small, lonely island with his beautiful young daughter, Miranda. Prospero doesn't want to live on this island, but he has no choice. His bad brother, Antonio, says he is the Duke of Milan and Prospero cannot return to the city.

Prospero and Miranda are not the only people on the little island. There is also a magic spirit called Ariel and a monster called Caliban. Prospero is now their master, and they are his slaves.¹

Prospero is a magician. He is very clever and he knows a lot about magic and spells² from his books. Ariel helps Prospero with his magic.

Alonso, Antonio, Alonso's son Ferdinand, Sebastian and Gonzalo are on the King's boat. Prospero decides to punish³ his brother Antonio. He is going to send a big storm, a tempest.



1. **slaves** : prisoners who must work.
2. **spells** : things which happen because someone says some magic words.
3. **punish** : do something to hurt someone because of their bad actions.
